This cable controlled base jump offers a new kind of free falling thrill with wide appeal because of it's controlled descent. The Sky Jump is reputed to be the highest public tower base jump in the world.

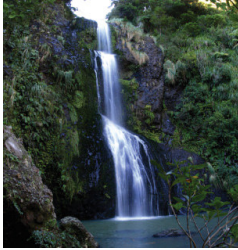
